

A Note From the Pastor

Growing up, Christmas didn't just happen in my house, it kind of oozed out of every corner in our house. I am still amazed to this day how my mom found things like Christmas themed Kleenex box holders. When I was in college, I loved to go back home for Christmas, but I wasn't sure why, other than the break from cafeteria food. Now, I realize it was because when I went home during the Holiday Season, I was surrounded by love and seemed to experience Christmas in every moment.

I have come to understand that the real meaning of Christmas is not found in perfect theologies I heard in Seminary. Christmas is instead found in remembering that the whole point of Christmas is the incarnation of Christ; that God came down to earth and poured himself into a little baby, who was born amidst the smells and sounds of farm animals. This is Christmas: the real, experienced event that sticks in our memories because of the food, laughter, gifts, songs, smells, and joy of living in these moments.

As we come into Advent and start to get ready for Christmas, I encourage you to go all out. Make as big a deal of Christmas as you think you can get away with, because I believe that is precisely what God wants. This very God who spent so lavishly on us, wants us to spend lavishly on ourselves and our loved ones. Now, I don't mean simply spending money. I mean spending time, effort, energy, and most importantly, prioritizing Christmas. In this way, Christmas will not be simply a two week holiday from school, or a chance to get a few more material possessions. Instead, we will remember that people singing about joy and light while they're standing in the cold and dark is Christmas; that the sound of paper ripping as gifts are opened is Christmas, that the sweet taste of once a year cookies and treats is Christmas, and that the warm embrace of family and friends being together is Christmas.

Christmas is not about the theoretical, but is about the practical, the tangible. Christmas is meant to be experienced, meant to be celebrated, meant to be incarnate (literally "enfleshed") in our lives. So, prioritize celebrating Christmas! And, if you do, I believe the true meaning of Christmas will shine into your lives: we have a God who loves us so much that we are given life abundant. A life abounding with joy because of how richly filled it is with love, both now and in the days to come. Prioritize Christmas, and you won't be able to miss all the love in your life.
