

#### A Note From the Pastor, Spring has Sprung (by leak and crack)?

It is too early to call it "spring", but our current thaw is generally meet with joy. We are mostly glad for the respite from the sub-zeros temps. We can wash our vehicles. We can get those sidewalks clean. We can bring out the roof leak buckets (yes, this is our reality too).

Buy (*intentionally misused word*) now, you know about the water coming down from our roof problems. The flat roof has given 30 years and needs to be replaced. We have several active leaks. So, while most are enjoying the late-January thaw, that's not the case inside our building. We have 4 active leaks and we expect more before spring and continuing 'till whenever the reroofing work begins. You can help by emptying buckets and giving monies for the roof replacement.

Recently we have also had water coming up from our underground broken water pipe. The only visible remains is the pile of snow/slush/mud/ice near the 5<sup>th</sup> street parking lot entrance. While we may wonder how our new president will react with "3 AM calls", I can tell you from experience how Jack Anderson reacts. He also knows who to call to get it fixed. I also know how Aaron Nissan reacts with his frequent checks and repairs.

Anxiously the staff watched the heavy machinery come and go, while wondering what impact the lack of water would have on our various ministries. Fortunately, we did not have to evacuate our homeless guests, nor cancel the preschool or Kindermusic. All the work (locating, digging, more digging and even more digging), fixing the cracked pipe and covering it all back again was accomplished that same day with only minor inconveniences. You can help with contributing towards the repair/replacement.

I've never encountered so many building repair needs in any of my congregations or interims as there have been here at St. John. I have every confidence we will get them all done. I have come to know that "Community in Christ- Christ in Community – Active in Love" is more than just a tag phrase here. TGBG! – Interim Pastor Paul
