#### **Lent is Almost Here!**

### **Comforter Drive for Bright Sky Apartments**

This year Lent begins on February 14th (Valentine's Day). As we prepare for Ash Wednesday and the season of Lent we would like to extend an invitation and a challenge to our St. John community to consider celebrating God's gift of love by providing the warmth of a comforter to our brothers and sisters who are transitioning out of homelessness into apartments. Valentine's Day provides for us an opportunity each year to recognize and celebrate the gift of love in our lives. Perhaps this year we can take up the challenge of extending God's gift of love to our neighbors who are transitioning out of the difficult and painful reality of homelessness into the hope and promise of new life with a place to call home.

The new transitional apartment complex (Bright Sky) will be opening this March, and Churches United is hoping to help furnish the apartments before their first tenants move in from the shelter. Our Social Concerns Committee has provided us with a registry of items needed to help furnish these apartments. Recalling with fondness how well the pillow drive for the shelter went a few years ago during VBS, we thought it might be helpful to focus on one particular item on that registry. Therefore, we provided the registry of items to our youth and they voted for their favorite items. The majority vote fell on bed comforters, so we have decided to lead a drive for new, twin- or queen-sized comforters.

Isaiah 40:1 says "Comfort, O comfort my people says the Lord." Let us rally around this verse as we provide warmth and a comforter to our brothers and sisters in Christ who are transitioning out of homelessness and into an apartment of their very own.

If you would prefer to pick up any of the other items on the Bright Sky Apartment registry, you are welcome to do so, and you can bring those items in rather than a comforter. There is a registry available on the TV cart in the entry area, or you can go to stjohnfargo.com and click on the link "Household items Needed for Churches United". Monetary gifts are welcome as well, so if you prefer to write a check please make it out to St. John and in the memo line write "Churches United" or "Bright Sky Apartments".
