A Note from the Pastor...

Lamentations 3:21-24 ²¹*But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope:* ²²*The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases, his mercies never come to an end;* ²³*they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.* ²⁴*"The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him."*

This year of 2020 has been in many ways uniquely different than others we have seen. This year has brought with it a pandemic that has reshaped our communal life together. Many of our normal rhythms and routines have shifted in drastic ways this year, and for a lot of us this shift has brought with it a deep sense of social dislocation.

In our household, our kids are currently going to school a few days each week and then doing their schooling remotely from home on the other days. Soon they will begin a time of virtual school until virus numbers in our county slow down. Much of our fall programming at St. John is also changing as we find ways to adapt and do our best to safeguard the health and emotional wellbeing of the kids and adults in our congregation.

Based upon the constant change and uncertainty that this time has brought with it, I think it can be easy to get discouraged. I would imagine many of you (like me) want life to return to a normal rhythm. My heart aches over the fact that we have had to say goodbye to some wonderful and good friends over these past months, and because of this virus, many of their families have had to make the difficult decision to wait on holding a memorial service for them. My daughter and her 9th grade class at St. John have agreed to wait until the spring to celebrate their

Confirmation. Many of our musical groups, along with other ministries, have had to find ways to either meet differently or postpone meeting for the time being. Indeed, I think many of us are ready for this COVID-19 time to be over.

It can be easy to get discouraged and lose heart during this time of uncertainty and dislocation. Yet, as I've reflected on the Lamentations reading, it occurs to me that while we may be living in a time of great uncertainty and change we have a God who has promised to faithfully stay beside us through it all. The writer of Lamentations writes to the people of Israel during a similar time of social dislocation and challenge. In the midst of his lament he notes that though life may seem hard, and at times painfully uncertain, God's faithfulness to us is never ending. It is a reason for us to hold onto hope, even when despair threatens to overwhelm us.

Perhaps as we all do our best to make it through this time of uncertainty and dislocation, we can try to take heart in the faithfulness of a loving God who has promised to be with us through the trials and tribulations that life brings our way. Please know that as we make our way through this together, I give thanks every day for God's faithfulness and for each and every one of you! May God continue to provide you with strength to make it through this time and may Christ's peace rest upon all of your hearts and lives this day and in the days to come.

Our current plan is to use the Fargo Public Schools opening model as our primary decision making guide. This model uses infection numbers from Cass County to determine the level of openness. We have adapted this for our church community, and will be taking other factors in account as necessary. We appreciate your continuing support and understanding as we live into an uncertain future. Please know that St. John leadership takes seriously its responsibility to keep our community safe as well as communicate the gospel and protect the mission of the church. We will adjust this model as necessary as we move into the fall, so please be sure to check with the office to see where we currently stand.

weather could ruin this plan on any Sunday, and we would like you to get used to checking Facebook, emails, or the answering machine message at the church office for updated information the night before worship. In addition, **worship will be LIVE on Facebook**. Those of us who have been to outdoor worship have loved seeing each other. Everyone wears masks and we will continue to paint circles in the grass so family groups can sit together and keep social distance. Blessings to you all!

Please keep the following in mind when we worship outside:

- We will have a hybrid **lawn and parking lot** worship service. You are invited to bring your own lawn chairs or blankets and sit on the lawn while you worship with us. **Or**, you can drive into the parking lot and stay in your car if you prefer.
- **We encourage you to stay home if** you are high risk or if you are coughing and sneezing for any reason (even if it's just allergies). While outdoors and in cars is extremely low risk, coughing and sneezing could add some risk for people around us, even outdoors. Stay home if you have symptoms of, or recent exposure to COVID-19.
- Please wear a facemask if possible, even while outdoors. The St. John Church Council passed a resolution stating that the council "invites and encourages staff and members to wear facemasks in public when possible." Part of this is safety, but this is also about leadership. The CDC recommends that we wear facemasks when possible. This would be an opportunity for St. John to demonstrate leadership in this area by wearing facemasks while in public when possible.
- The building will be open for people to use the restrooms. We are asking that everyone

wear a facemask while in the building, and that only one family uses the restroom at a time.

- “Weather permitting” in this case means that if it is rainy or too windy or cold, we will not worship outdoors. We will do our best to publish any cancellation by 10:00pm the Saturday evening prior to worship. But, it would be best to check your email or our Facebook page or call the office before you leave if you’re unsure.

- Finally, this will be a different worship experience, not necessarily a better worship experience. We are not encouraging people to mingle or to shake hands. We won’t do communion except on October 4. If you are going to talk to people you haven’t seen for a while, please keep a 6-foot distance, even outdoors or if talking through a car window. We have to remember that even though we may be comfortable with a shorter distance, others may not be. (And, as Midwesterners, we may not tell you how we feel.)

Communion Sunday

We will have communion on Sunday, October 4. If the weather is nice and we worship outdoors, feel free to bring your own elements (please follow open container laws) or use the ones provided.

On Sundays that we have outdoor worship (weather permitting), we’re looking for volunteers to hand out bulletins, guide people to the circles in the grass, help set up, etc. Volunteers will need to arrive at 9:00am.

St. John Receives North Dakota Economic Resiliency Grant

St. John Lutheran received over \$30,000 in grant money from the North Dakota Economic Resiliency Grant. The grant funds will be used primarily to help preschool operate in a safe manner, as well as to help purchase projectors and screens for the worship space. By using projectors and screens in our sanctuary, will not need to utilize bulletins or hymnals during worship, thereby reducing our risk of contact transmission.
