### A Note from the Pastor...

I am excited to announce that St. John Lutheran Church is embarking on a year of learning around the topics of social inequality and racial injustice. At its December meeting, St. John's Church Council passed a resolution dedicating 2021 as a year of education and self-discovery around how our society is structured unfairly so that we might better live out our mission statement: *Welcomed in Christ. Called to community. Sent to serve.* 


The church council and I believe strongly that one of the central activities of the church is welcoming others, and our mission statement begins intentionally with the word welcomed. So, just as Christ has welcomed us, we are called to welcome others, regardless of how different they might be from us (Romans 15:7). It is these differences that we will be studying. How can we welcome others unless we have a better understanding of their lives and their history? In addition, we must learn more about our own history in relation to our neighbors.

As Christians, we are called to be leaders in showing love to our neighbor. The first step we should take is to seek understanding. If we are to truly welcome the neighbor, we must be willing to acknowledge that we do not understand everything that our neighbors have experienced or endured; the pervasive and systemic differences that made headline after headline this past year. It is very possible that without this understanding, we will not be able to welcome others as Christ has welcomed us. We begin this year by learning about the structural underpinnings of American society. We will examine the book, "Caste," by Isabel Wilkerson. In this book, Wilkerson argues that American society is actually a "caste" system, much like in India. We will have a variety of options for engagement with this book, from weekly book clubs, to monthly discussion groups, and a one-time gathering (look for sign-ups in your email and on Facebook). We will also be focusing our Adult Forums on this topic with a variety of speakers from around the world. They will help us learn about how America looks from other perspectives as they share their own insights and stories.

I invite you to join us as we begin this journey of self-discovery. The easiest way to begin is to attend our Adult Forums in January (live via Zoom or later via YouTube). If you are interested in the book "Caste," and need help getting a copy, please let us know. Above all, I know that there may be moments where we learn things about ourselves that are difficult, but, in the end, we will begin to understand that it's not really about us, but about God's hope and call for us and for our church. Our mission as a church begins by welcoming others as we have been welcomed. And, lest we forget, we have been welcomed in grace by a God whose love is poured out on us abundantly.
