A Note from the Pastor...

Right after Halloween and All Saints' Day, we turn our attention to Thanksgiving. For many of us, Thanksgiving has a wonderful meaning and tradition. It a day for family, food, and maybe even some football. While we might not pause to openly reflect upon how thankful we are for all the blessings we have, I'm certain that we are aware of how richly God has blessed us. I wonder though if we couldn't take that reflection a little deeper, and not just on and around Thanksgiving. For me, Thanksgiving is about gratitude, but I also believe that gratitude is not meant for one holiday during the year. Rather, many people have now come to realize that gratitude should be an important part of everyday life.

If we begin to reflect more often on how much grace God gives us, we will be better able to be grateful for all that we do have. It is this gratitude that will begin to change how we see the world. Looking at the world through grateful eyes will show us that we are indeed fortunate and already have all that we need. And, gratitude like that will start to change our world, which is what God had in mind all along.
