A Note from the Pastor...

As part of St. John Lutheran's continuing understanding of God's mission in the world, the church council, Pastor Brian and I are pleased to announce a new mission statement for St. John Lutheran Church: Welcomed in Christ, Called to Community, Sent to Serve. We have been talking about a new mission statement for a while now, and are excited that we are now able to focus our ministry through the lens of this new statement. We believe that this statement will keep our attention on what God has in store for St. John.

By beginning with the phrase, *Welcomed in Christ*, St. John embraces all people who enter our doors, just as Christ welcomes all of us. We are all made equal by our baptism into Christ's grace, and so it is essential that our mission statement begins with this baptismal identity and the grace that it conveys. Only by being humbled and accepted by God's grace are we truly able to welcome others. And, for St. John, this welcome extends beyond our front doors, bringing welcome to others in our community and in our lives who need grace the most.

As a people who are welcomed in Christ, we are then *Called to Community*. St. John has long used the word Community in its understanding of God's mission in the world. We believe that God calls us to community, but not just any community. God desires for us a community rooted in the abiding love and presence of Christ. We are invited into this fellowship so that we may be better equipped to face challenges in our everyday lives, as well as being better able to minister to others around us.

As this called and gathered community, we are then *Sent to Serve* others, so that God's love and grace may be experienced throughout the world. St. John's history is filled with wonderful and amazing examples of faith active in love. Our mission statement continues that calling for us as individuals and as a church. How might we be part of God's unfolding love for the entire world? As we have been given grace and equipped for the journey, we now go out into the world to be good news for all people.

St. John's new mission statement can be easily remembered with the three verbs that begin each phrase: welcomed, called, sent. I hope that these three words might become part of your identity so that every day you know that God has welcomed you in Christ, called you to community so that you may feel uplifted, and sent you out into the world to serve others as you are able. As we live out this mission statement, I believe St. John will begin to see God's vision for what this church can become.



Care for Creation Committee: What does 'Care for Creation' mean to you?

When asked to consider what the phrase "care for creation" means to me:

At first, care sounds like a soft word to me. But when I consider the word for more than a few seconds and look beyond its use/abuse in marketing, and when I think of words that cluster around it – attention, provision, protection, love - my eyes open a bit to its depth. It's similar to "love" but with commitment and action attached to it. I'm reminded of my grandfather, who suffered with and cared for my grandma as she struggled off and on with illness for the last few decades of her life.

One of the questions I struggle with most is how we can live in a place without degrading it (or worse). I don't have answers, but at a minimum, I think it helps to have a tangible connection to a place. To notice, like a young child does, the beauty and small miracles that happen there (and here!). Connection and intimacy help to enable the kind of care and love and creative solutions needed by our neighbors, our land/ air/water, and our descendants who will live in this place one-hundred years from now.


