## A Note from the Pastor...

“Christ has risen, He is risen indeed, Alleluia!”

Now that’s Easter!

Hearing this promise proclaimed with certainty and joy along with the trumpets and choirs at worship on Easter is what Easter is all about right?

In our gospel reading for Easter Sunday this year we will hear from the Gospel of Mark as he tells the story of Jesus' resurrection. As Mark tells the story we will hear that the women went to the tomb to anoint Jesus’ body, but when they arrived they were told that Jesus was not there, that he had risen. However, in this Gospel telling of the resurrection story we find out that upon hearing this news they fled from the tomb in terror and said nothing, for they were afraid.

Not exactly the ending that most of us were looking for. No cheers of “Alleluia, Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!” No trumpets sounding, no joyful celebrations of this amazing event of Jesus’ resurrection. In Mark’s gospel we don’t get to see the resurrected Jesus. All we get is a promise from a man in the tomb that Jesus has been raised and the women are told to go tell the disciples and Peter that Jesus is going ahead of them to Galilee. And then the women leave the tomb, in terror and amazement, and they don’t say a word to anyone, because we are told that they were afraid.

Why would Mark tell us that the women left the tomb in terror and amazement, but then never told anyone because of fear?

*Pastor's Note—Continued from page 1:*

Maybe it's because Mark knows the truth about us, that our lives are so often lived in moments just like that. Moments of terror and amazement. Moments of fear and hope. Every day, we live our lives between hope and fear. Like these women, we to are uncertain what to do with this promise.

In the gospel of Mark, all we get is an empty tomb and frightened disciples. But we also get a promise. That Jesus will meet us in Galilee. In this life. In this life that exists between moments of great fear and moments of great hope. The risen Lord will not allow us to stay in the tomb of fear and hopelessness. We are invited to go to Galilee where the journey began, to our everyday lives, trusting that the story, God's story, isn't over yet.

Because your life is the resurrection. Because in your life is where the resurrected Jesus promises to meet you. God will not stay in the grave. This love for you and for the world will not be buried. But God will go before you in love. Which means that wherever you go, God has already been there.

If you enter an MRI machine, Jesus has gone ahead of you and will meet you there. If you have to walk to a graveside and bury a loved one, Jesus has gone ahead of you and will meet you there. If you have to walk into chemotherapy, if you have to walk into the divorce lawyer's office, if you have to walk into a therapist's office because life is simply crushing you, Jesus has already gone ahead of you, and will meet you there.

Indeed, this is our Easter promise and our Easter hope that wherever we go God will meet us there. What an amazing promise to call us forward not in fear but in hope. Happy Easter to you all!




